Uniform Code

Seventh Grade

St. John's is a mandatory uniform school. Students are required to adhere to the school's uniform code.

Navy blue or Khaki bottom and Navy Blue polo with logo.

Shoes : black, white, blue, brown, gray or a combination of those colors. **No light up shoes.**

Socks : white, blue, brown, gray.

Eucharist Uniform (Thursday only)

Boys Khaki bottom, oxford shirt with logo and school tie. Navy blue blazer . Black or brown dress shoes.

Girls – Plaid skirt/skort, oxford shirt with logo, school tie, navy blue sweater vest, black or brown dress shoes.

Socks : white, blue, brown, gray

Only black or brown belts are allowed. Jackets have to be plain navy blue, gray or white in color. No makeup/ Only clear nail polish is allowed. Only girls are allowed to wear one pair of small ear-rings/studs. No acrylic nails allowed.

No form of hair coloring is allowed for students. No designs in hair is allowed.

Friday is Spirit Day – Students are allowed to wear jeans and a school spirit shirt, any color shoes. Students will need to change out of jeans for PE.
