**Reopening Plan for 2020-2021 school year Plan A - Innovative Learning Plan (If the current state continues with the surge in numbers we are currently seeing. Uncontrolled community spread).**

St. John's will reopen school with distance learning on August 24<sup>th</sup>.

Teachers will be at school and will have Zoom accounts in order to facilitate teaching remotely.

There will be a schedule for each grade which needs to be strictly adhered to. Classes will be held online from 9 am to 12 noon Monday – Friday. Students will be given assignments to be completed for the next day. Attendance will be taken daily.

Logging in is MADATORY. The student will be marked absent if they do not attend class.

Students need to log in on a tablet or computer and be visible to the teacher (it will be like being present in class, just remotely). Please call the office if there is a device issue.

All assigned work will need to be completed on time - NO EXCEPTIONS.

We plan to do this for two to four weeks and then will go to Plan A once it is deemed safe.

We are planning for free grab and go food service. Hours to be announced.
