Summer Reading

All students at St. John's are required to do book reports during the summer. Students may choose 2 books from the attached list.

Attached you will find 2 pages that may be used for the reports. All reports should include the name of the book and the author. The reports need to be 5-10 sentences long, and include a picture that is hand drawn and colored.

For one report your child may choose to do an assignment other than a written book report.

- Make a diorama (shoebox) of their favorite part of the story. Bring to share with the class. Be able to talk about your story.
- Make a painting on posterboard of your favorite part of the story. Be able to talk about your story.
- Make a picture poster of the main characters. Draw and label pictures of the main characters. Be able to tell about each character when you present it to the class.
- Write a poem about the story or one of the main characters. Dress up like your character when you present to class.
- Make up a song about your story. Sing for your classmates.

Please help your child realize that reading should be fun and exciting. Help them become a better reader and develop a life long love of reading. And don't forget to visit the library.

Uniform Code

St. John's is a mandatory uniform school. Students are required to adhere to the school's uniform code.

Kindergarten – Fourth Grades

Only students in grades Kindergarten and First grade are allowed to come to school in PE uniform on PE days (Mon/Wed/Fri).

Navy blue bottom and light blue polo with logo.

Shoes : black, white, blue, brown, gray or a combination of those colors. No light up shoes.

Socks : white, blue, brown, gray.

Eucharist Uniform (Thursday only)

Boys Navy blue bottom, oxford shirt with logo and school tie. Black or brown dress shoes.

Girls – Plaid jumper, oxford shirt with logo, school tie, black or brown dress shoes.

Socks : white, blue, brown, gray.

Only black or brown belts are allowed. Jackets have to be plain navy blue, gray or white in color. No makeup/ Only clear nail polish is allowed. Only girls are allowed to wear one pair of small ear-rings/studs. No acrylic nails allowed.

No form of hair coloring is allowed for students. No designs in hair is allowed.

Friday is Spirit Day – Students are allowed to wear jeans and a school spirit shirt, any color shoes. Students will need to change out of jeans for PE.
