Non-Fiction –

A true story about an event, a person, or a place

- Julian’s Glorious Summer – Ann Cameron

Mystery –

The characters are trying to figure something out that happened. It could be true or realistic fiction.

- Magic Tree House Series – Mary Osborne (Any book)
- Boxcar Children Mysteries – Gertrude Chandler Warner (Any book)

***Please be advised the summer assignments are mandatory and they will be part of the first quarter Language Arts grade.**

Students are required to log on to [khanacademy.org](https://www.khanacademy.org) or other comparable sites and complete math activities for third grade level. 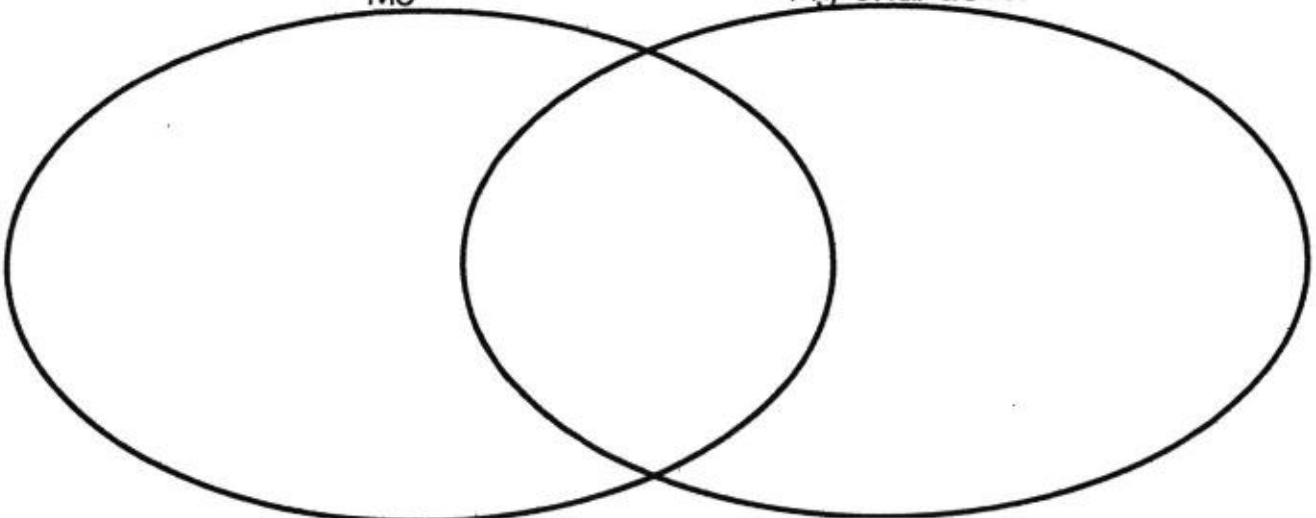

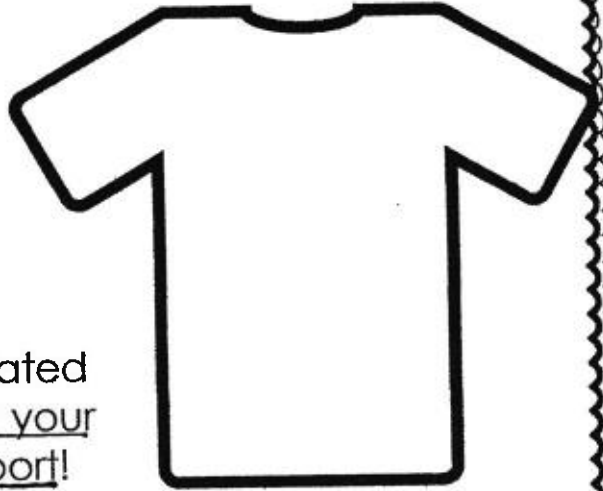

T-Shirt Book Report



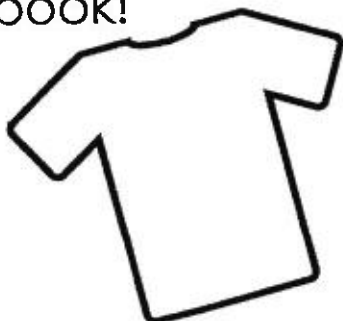
Your assignment is to design a t-shirt related to the book you just read. You will wear your t-shirt when you present your book report!

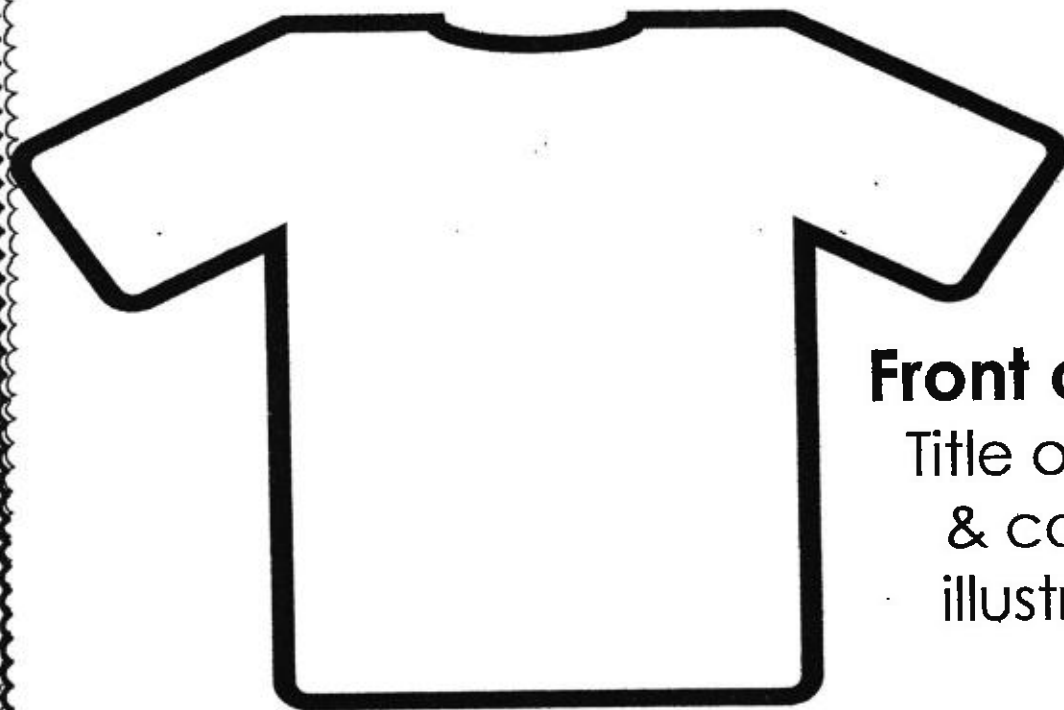

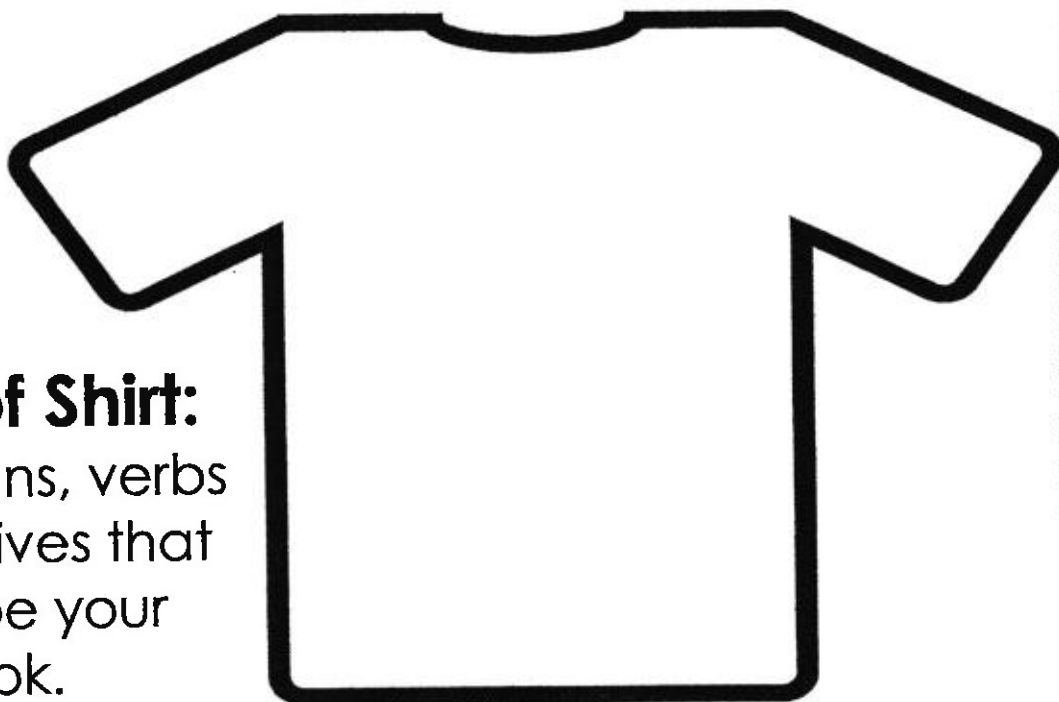
