The characters are trying to figure something out that happened. It could be true or realistic fiction.

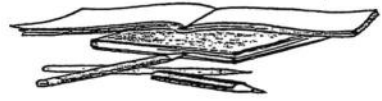
- Magic Tree House Series – Mary Osborne (Any book)

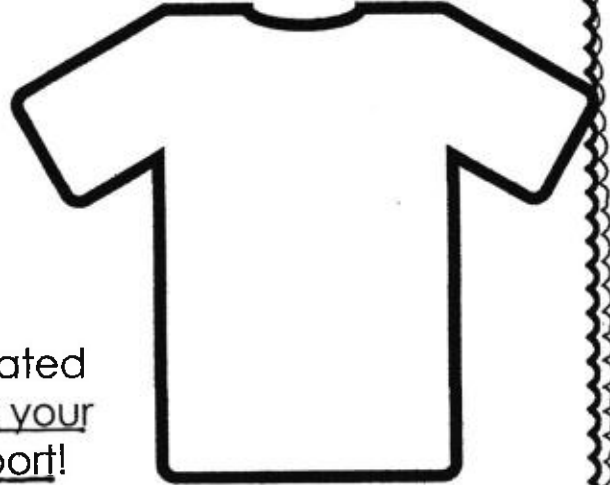

# T-Shirt Book Report



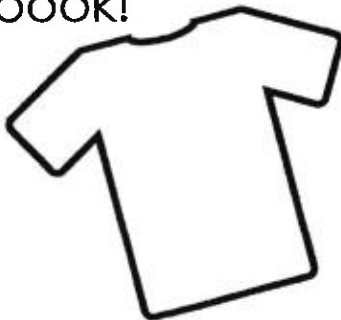
Your assignment is to design a t-shirt related to the book you just read. You will wear your t-shirt when you present your book report!

**Back of T-Shirt:** Write 10-15 nouns, verbs, and adjectives that describe your book's plot, setting & characters. Make sure to use words that will grab people's attention and make them want to read your book!



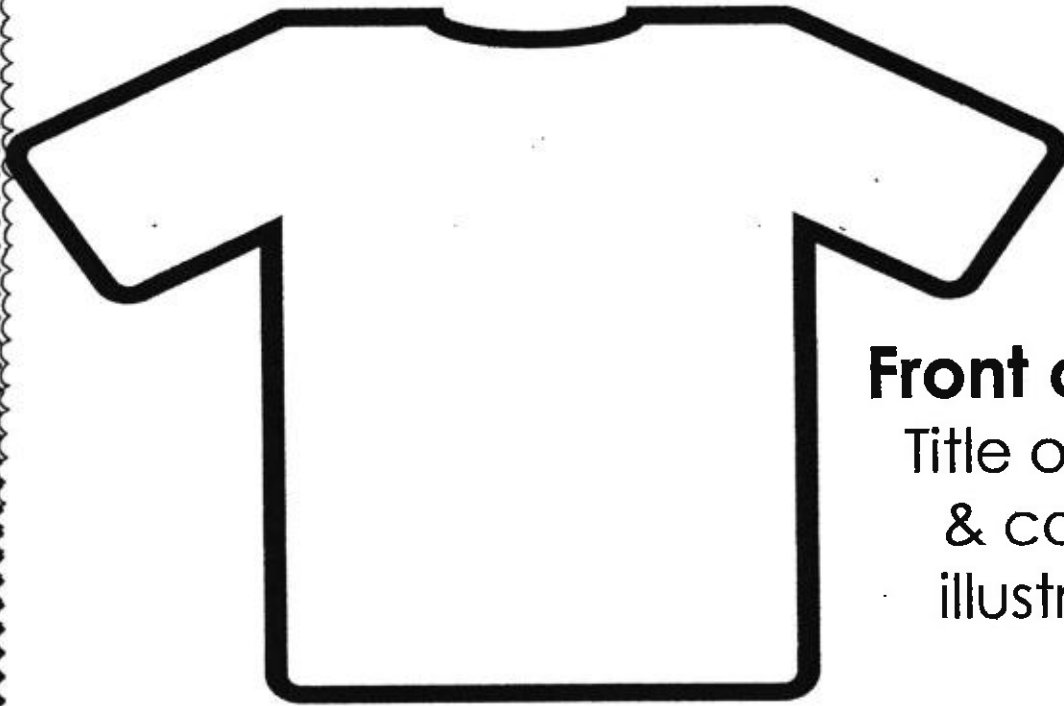

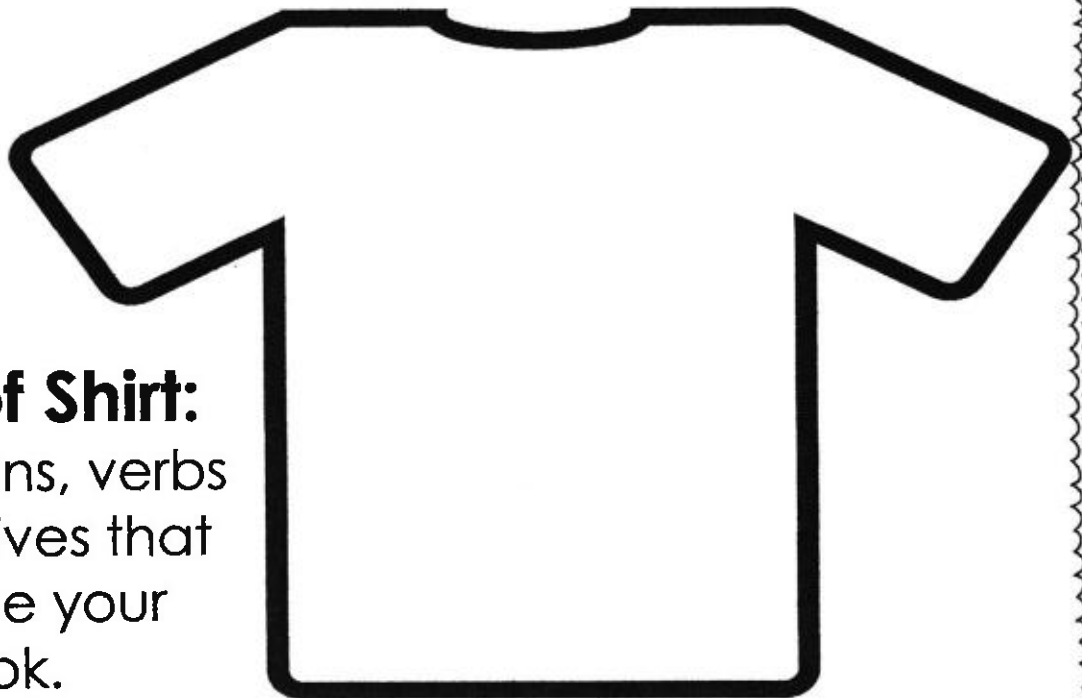
