Fifth Grade

St. John's is a mandatory uniform school. Students are required to adhere to the school's uniform code.

Navy blue bottom and Burgundy/Maroon polo with logo.

Shoes: black, white, blue, brown, gray or a combination of those colors. No light up shoes.

Socks: white, blue, brown, gray.

Eucharist Uniform (Thursday only)

Boys Navy blue bottom, oxford shirt and school tie. Black or brown dress shoes.

Girls – Plaid skirt, oxford shirt with navy blue sweater vest, school tie, black or brown dress shoes.

Socks: white, blue, brown, gray

Only black or brown belts are allowed. Jackets have to be plain navy blue, gray or white in color. No makeup/ Only clear nail polish is allowed. Only girls are allowed to wear one pair of small ear-rings/studs. No acrylic nails allowed.

No form of hair coloring is allowed for students. No designs in hair is allowed.

<u>Friday is Spirit Day – Students are allowed to wear jeans and a school spirit shirt, any color</u> shoes. Students will need to change out of jeans for PE.

Leggings can be wore under shorts/skirt or skort on a cold days.
